The violinist KOVÁCS EMŐKE studied at the Sigismund Toduță High School of Music in Cluj Napoca, she is a graduate of the Gheorghe Dima Music Academy in Cluj Napoca in the class of Prof. Béres Melinda; completed her master's studies at the same institution.

Between 1998 and 2000, the violinist was a member of the Hungarian State Opera in Cluj and since 2002 she has been a member of the Dinu Lipatti Satu Mare Philharmonic Orchestra, holding the position of the leader of the first violin section. She is also a violin teacher at the Aurel Popp Art High School in Satu Mare.

Throughout her career she has collaborated with the Hungarian Opera in Cluj Napoca, the Sigismund Toduță Music High School in Cluj

Napoca, the Escuela Superior de Artes Yucatan Faculty in Mexico and with the Yucatan Symphony Orchestra between 2005-2006.

She has taken part in numerous master classes in Hungary, Germany, Romania, collaborating with numerous orchestras in the country and abroad. She was a member of the Consonantia Chamber Band, a member of the Diletto Musicale Chamber Orchestra, the FourEver Quartet and the Quasi Così Trio, performing chamber concerts in the country and abroad.

Since December 2019 she is the manager of the Dinu Lipatti State Philharmonic in Satu Mare.
