



LILIANA STAICU

Musicologist and journalist, Liliana Staicu graduated the University of Music in Bucharest - Musicology Department - in 1987 and, after a short period in which she worked as a music teacher, she became member of the Radio Music Editorial Office. Later, she became member of the team that, in 1997, laid the foundations of Radio România Muzical.

Going through all the stages of her evolution as a radio journalist, in her over 30 years of activity, Liliana Staicu signed, as a producer, some of the most important and long-lived shows of the public station - "Politon stereo-Music first of all!" , "Folklore Sound Library", "5 Questions and a Prize", "Music Lovers Olympics", "Afternoon Prelude to a Music Lover", "Nonconformist Portrait" or "Stars Without

Borders", in addition to a whole series of live broadcasts of the most important national and international music events, including the "George Enescu" International Festival.

She has written concert chronicles in the Actualitatea muzicală magazine, in the newspaper of the "George Enescu" International Festival and in other music specialized publications.

In 2007 she became Editor-in-Chief and, later, Manager of Radio România Muzical. She was a member of the Culture Group of the European Radio and Television Union (EBU) and is currently part of the Working Group on the same European structure dedicated to radio music ensembles.

Since 2017, Liliana Staicu is also the Manager of the Romanian Radio Music Ensembles - a department that includes six of the most prestigious music ensembles in Romania.
